Softball Game Rules Overview

Prohibited Behaviors

- Metal Cleats: The use of metal cleats is strictly forbidden.
- **Behavior:** Any form of arguing or fighting will lead to immediate ejection from the game.

I. Gameplay Regulations

A. Team Requirements

- **Minimum Players:** At least 8 players are required to start and continue a game.
- Lineup Restrictions: Unfilled 9th and 10th spots result in automatic outs.
- Roster Size: A maximum of 15 players is allowed per team roster.

II. Game Mechanics

B. Timing

- Grace Period: A ten-minute grace period is permitted for the start of the first games.
- **Duration:** Games are capped at one hour and fifteen minutes or 7 innings, whichever occurs first.

C. Tournament Format

• Structure: The competition will follow a Double Elimination Tournament format.

III. Equipment and Playing Field

- D. Field Setup
 - Ball Specifications: 12-inch softballs are to be used.
 - Field Dimensions: Bases are set 65 feet apart, with the pitching rubber 50 feet from home plate.

IV. Playing Rules

E. Offense

- Scoring Rules: Run rules are 15 runs after 4 innings, and 10 runs after 5 innings.
- Home Run Limit: A limit of 5 home runs per team per game is enforced.
- **Bat Regulations:** Only bats approved by ISA/NSA/USSSA/ASA are allowed.

F. Administration

• Line-Up Submission: Line-ups must be given to the scorekeeper and the opposing team before the game starts.

G. Batting

• Initial Count: Each batter starts with a 1 and 1 count, plus one additional foul is allowed.

H. Prohibited Actions

• In-Game Conduct: Fake tags and stealing are strictly prohibited.
